### Labyrinth Walking Schedule

<b>Sunday, April 2</b>	<b>3:00 PM – 7 pm</b>
<b>Monday, April 3-Thursday, April 6</b>	<b>9 AM – 6 pm</b>
<b>Friday, April 7</b> <i>Good Friday Service</i>	<b>10 AM – 1 pm</b> <b>12:00 - 1:00 pm</b>

*People may walk during the service and afterwards, until 1:00 pm when the Labyrinth closes.*

*Labyrinth walking is an ancient practice used by many different faiths for spiritual centering, contemplation, and prayer.*

*Entering the serpentine path of a labyrinth, you walk slowly while quieting your mind and focusing on a spiritual question or prayer.*

*You'll find prayer stations around the perimeter which support your intentions with tangible symbols. Gentle, contemplative music will accompany you as you take this pilgrimage of the heart.*

*You are invited to reaffirm your baptism (according to your tradition) at the baptismal pool. Please feel free to share your reflections in the community journal.*
